Summer Reading Series Kicks Off June 15 in Partnership with 100 Black Men Las Vegas

Join Library District Executive Director Kelvin Watson as he introduces the new Summer Reading Series with 100 Black Men Las Vegas, as they read and discuss the gripping New York Times Best-Selling novel by Angie Thomas The Hate U Give. Light refreshments will be served and you can access the book, eBook, audiobook, or movie for FREE using your library card.

Published in 2017, The Hate U Give centers on 16-year-old Starr Carter, whose world is shattered at the fatal shooting of her childhood best friend Khalil at the hands of a police officer. Khalil was unarmed.

The Summer Reading Series will include reading sections of The Hate U Give and then joining in group discussions, led by members of 100 Black Men Las Vegas, about this gripping novel. After the kickoff event, the full discussions begin on June 29 at three locations - West Las Vegas Library, Sahara West Library, and

Centennial Hills Library. Details here.

In addition, FREE screenings of the 2018 major motion picture from the novel will take place in July. The Summer Reading Series will conclude on August 3 with a wrap-up discussion, featuring Kelvin Watson.
