### **Discover Your Family History**

For the first time, you can view records from the 1950 U.S. Census data, which were recently released by the National Archive and are FREE to library card holders through HeritageQuest. This information can help you discover how the Great Depression, World War II, and the start of the Baby Boom affected your family. The library also offers FREE library versions of other popular and effective genealogy services such as Ancestry.com.

For a deeper dive into your family tree, explore the FREE services from the Las Vegas Family Search Center on August 3 from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. at the East Las Vegas Library. The center offers one-on-one assistance, computers and equipment to convert old media types such as photos, tapes, slides, and film to digital formats, and free software to record family trees, memories, and stories.
