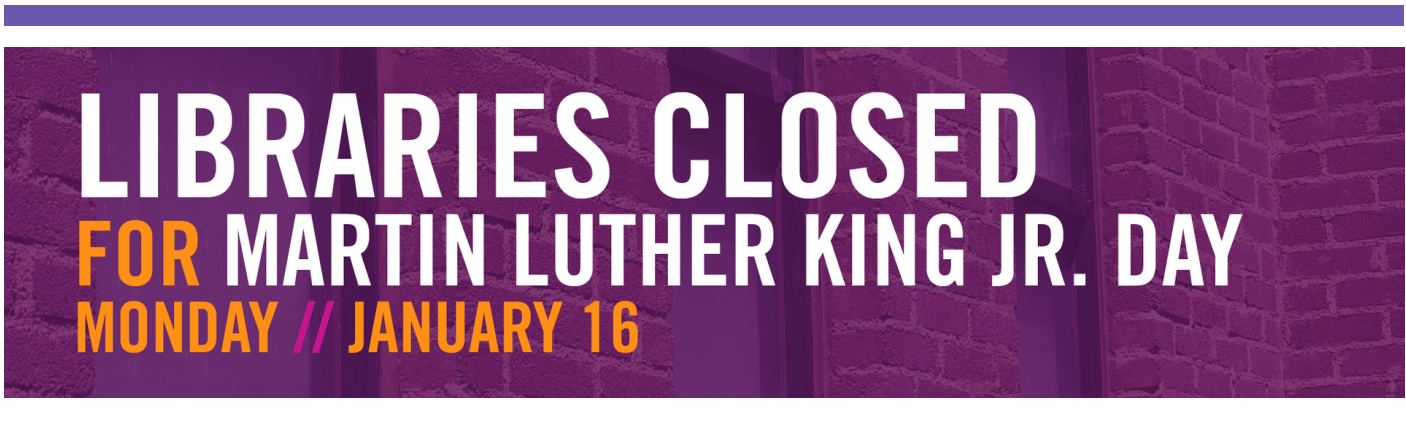
Now Available! VGK Bookmark Featuring #7 Alex Pietrangelo

Genealogy Workshops Help You Discover Your Family's History




