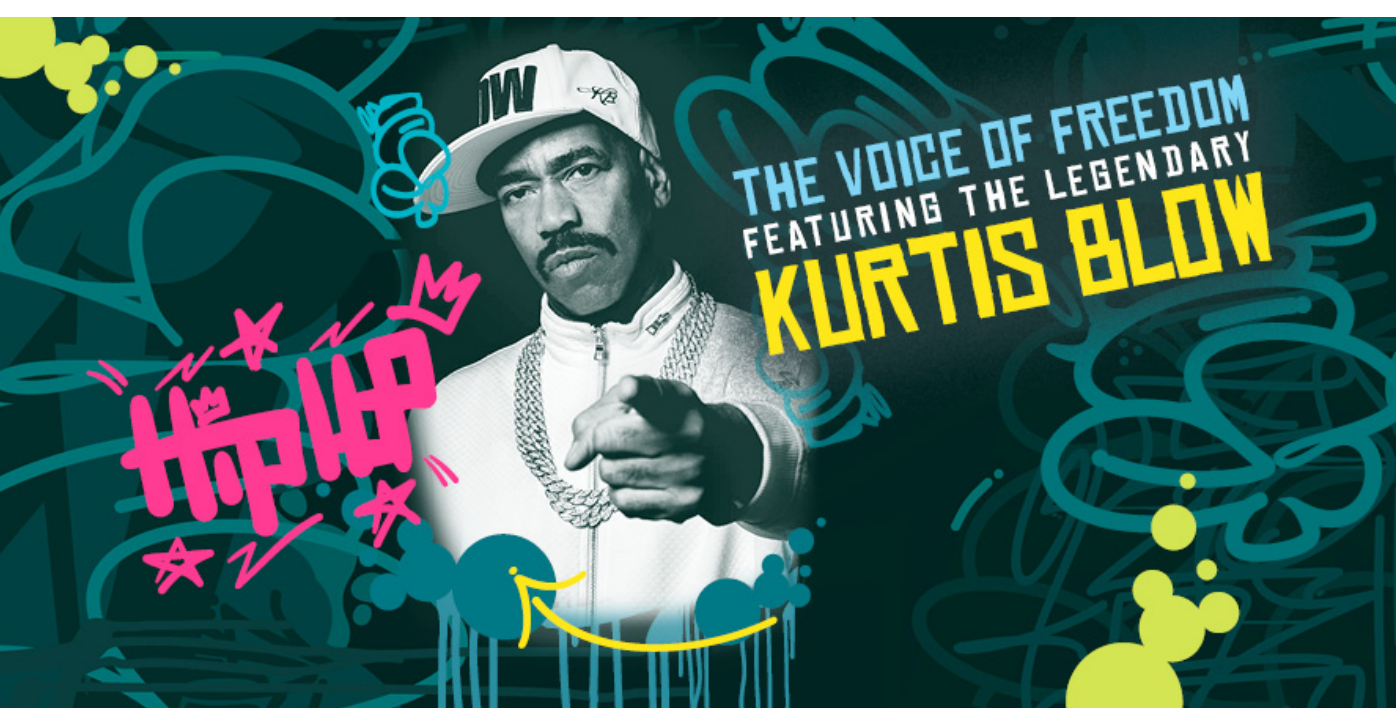
Celebrate LGBTQIA+ Pride Month
