

Library cardholders who qualify for the new FREE Personal WiFi Program can visit any participating Library District branch and check out a FREE Personal WiFi Card. These cards each contain a unique User ID and Password, and will provide FREE internet access until June 30, 2024. For cardholders in areas where Cox WiFi service is limited, please visit your nearby branch to check out a Library District hotspot device.

In order to qualify for this FREE service, you must:

- Be age 18 years or older.
- Have a FREE Las Vegas-Clark County Library card.

FREE Personal WiFi Card for Qualified Customers

• Not currently have internet access to meet your educational and/or employment needs.

Important things to know about this FREE service:

- 1. WiFi access is limited to three devices.
- 2. There is no equipment to check out, just a WiFi card that will contain your Personal ID & Password. Cards are available while supplies last.
- 3. This service will be available to library cardholders NOW until June 30, 2024.
- 4. FREE Personal WiFi Cards are not available to place on hold, and are only available with a valid library card at participating branches.

FREE Fair Focuses on Health & Social Service Resources for Seniors, Adults & Families






