

The Library District Display Policy

The Las Vegas-Clark County Library District will display free materials as part of the commitment to collect, gather, and disseminate information. Given the specific branch limitations of space, the library programming staff will place materials in this succession:

- 1. Library Publication.
- 2. Governmental Publications.
- 3. State Registered Non-Profit Cultural Publications
- 4. Community-based newspapers produced by for-profit organizations but distributed Free of charge, with or without advertising. They must contain news and feature Articles relevant to either segments of a district-wide population or to smaller geographic areas within the District.

These newspapers may only be displayed and circulated if:

- a. The newspaper publisher contacts the Public Relations Manager for approval.
- b. The newspaper is delivered to each library at which it is to be displayed.
- c. The District reserves the right to limit the number of newspapers left for display and circulation, based upon demand.
- d. The District reserves the right to discard any items left after thirty (30) days.

Periodicals failing to meet these criteria may place one copy of their publication in the periodical's department for patrons to view. (Periodical: item published in successive parts bearing numerical chronological designation and intended to be continued indefinitely).

Thirty days prior to any local, state, or federal election the library will provide a space for all materials prepared for public distribution for the election. District branches serving as polling places will remove these materials at the end of the day preceding election poling in accordance with NRS 293.740.
