






Meet Molly & Get FREE School Supplies at Kickoff to Kindergarten


Convenient & Discreet Program Provides FREE Period Supplies




Show Your Love for the Library & Vote in Best of Las Vegas Awards

Entries Due Nov 1, 2024

The NASA TechRise Student Challenge empowers teams of sixth to 12th-grade students to design, build, and launch experiments on NASA-supported test flights. Guided by an educator, student teams affiliated with U.S. public, private, and charter schools can submit ideas for experiments to test on a high-altitude balloon flight with exposure to Earth's atmosphere and views of our planet. Sixty winning team will be selected to receive \$1,500 to build their experiment, technical support from Future Engineers, and an assigned spot for their experiment on a high-altitude balloon flight. No experience is needed.
