Agenda Item # IV.A.:

Discussion and possible Board action to approve a new contract for workers compensation insurance.

Background:

Nevada statutes do not require bidding of workers compensation insurance on a particular schedule. Traditionally, the District has selected an insurance carrier for an extended period of time. This decision is heavily weighted on the services they are able to offer, their claims handling, and cost.

On September 12, 2019, the Board of Trustees authorized the purchase of workers compensation through the District's Broker of Record from WCF Insurance Company for a period of five years subject to annual renewals per year from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2024. The District's current workers compensation insurance expires September 30, 2024.

The District's Workers Compensation Broker, Leavitt Group went out to bid in July 2024 and received two bids. The the first bid is from WCF insurance Company, the District's current vendor, and the second from Employers Insurance.

- (1) WCF is proposing an annual premium of \$120,878 for the upcoming year effective October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025. This is a decrease of \$989.
- (2) Employers is proposing an annual premium of \$100,958 for the upcoming year effective October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025. This is \$19,920 less than WCF.

As part of the bidding process, services offered, claims handling and experience were also evaluated in addition to cost.

Recommended Action: Motion to authorize the purchase of workers compensation insurance through the District's Broker of Record, Leavitt Group, from Employers Insurance Company with the provision for five additional annual renewals, subject to review by counsel.
