About Us

The Library District nurtures the social, economic, and educational well-being of people and communities. The Library District is committed to building communities of people who can come together to pursue their individual and group aspirations.

The Library District has 25 branches, serving 1.7 million people over 8,000 square miles.

We welcome over 810,000 people to 36,000 library-sponsored and community events each year.

Programming and Venues Department (PVS)

The PVS Department coordinates the use of our venues via partnerships and rentals. We partner with other government entities and non-profit institutions to present free and open public programs, without solicitation or commercial intent, that align with the Library District's strategic framework. All PVS facilities are available to rent on a first-come, first-served basis.

Our six performing arts centers, all with dedicated sound, lighting and projection equipment, are unique spaces offering varying performance options and seating capacities: Clark County (399 seats), Summerlin (284 seats), West Charleston (276 seats), West Las Vegas (295 seats), Whitney (198 seats) and Windmill (294 seats). The rental rate is \$40 per hour, with additional fees for technicians, security, and insurance (through a separate vendor). Reservations are accepted no more than 13 months and no less than six weeks in advance.

Our 18 meeting rooms at 15 library branches can accommodate up to 300 people. All of the meeting rooms have tables and chairs, and many feature audio-visual equipment. The rental rate is \$30 per hour, and reservations can be made up to six months in advance on our website (www.thelibrarydistrict.org), or in person at any library branch.

Summerlin Performing Arts Center

Summerlin Library Performing Arts Center is a proscenium theater with 284 seats and 2 wheelchair accessible spaces. It features a 30-line fly rail, a large attached loading dock, two large chorus dressing rooms, two-star dressing rooms and one quick change dressing room. This theatre is well suited for theatrical, dance, and music productions as well as lectures and pageants.

The Summerlin Library is located at 1771 Inner Circle Drive, Las Vegas, NV 89134, which is just off the Summerlin Parkway at the Town Center exit.

Library District rates for venues and labor apply for up to 8 hours. Time exceeding 8 hours of continuous use is charged at the overtime rate. A Technician Specialist is required for Performing Arts Center use and Security is required for after-hours use.

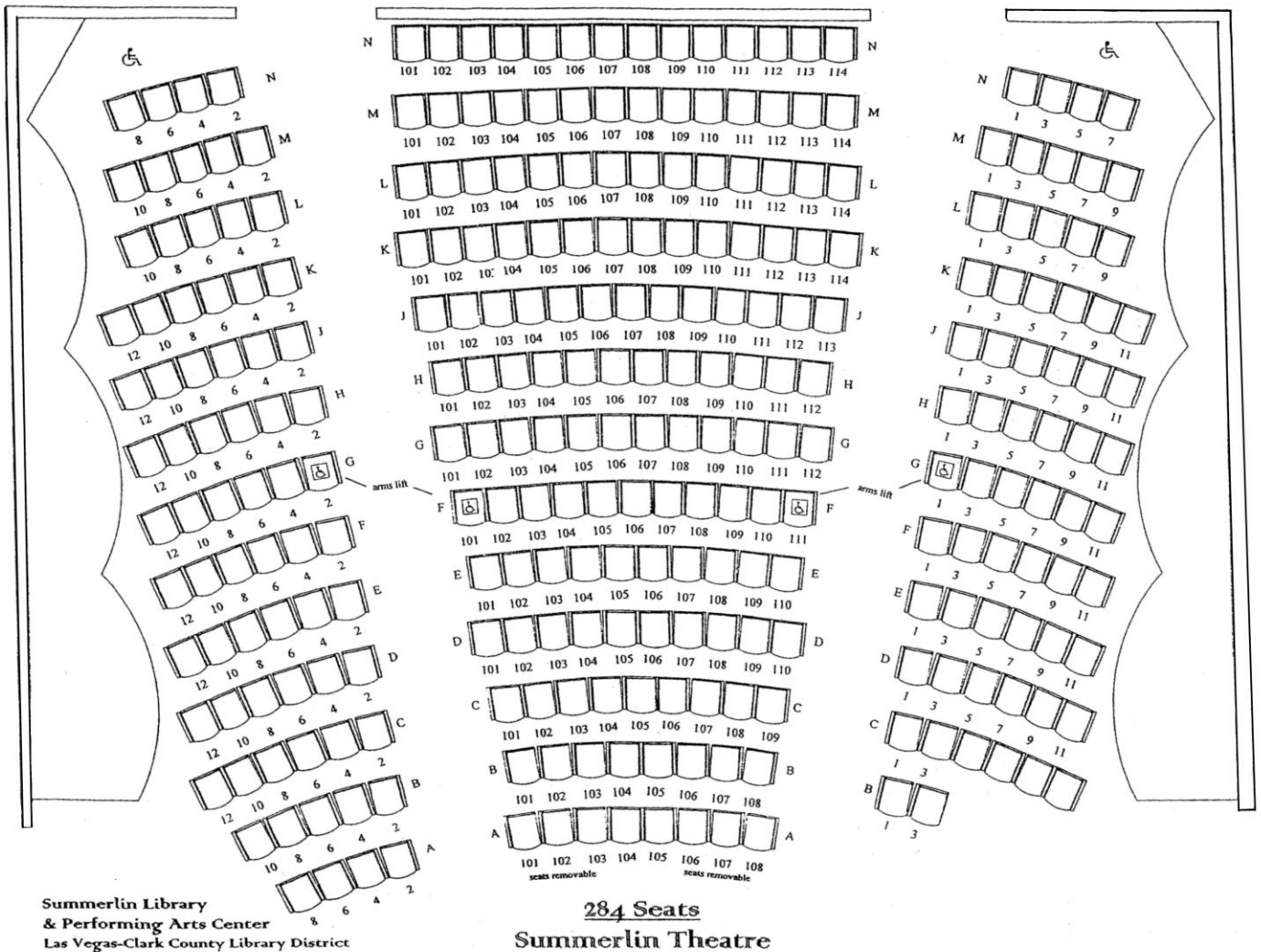

RIGGING SYSTEM

The Summerlin Library Theater has a single-purchase counterweight fly system which features 30 linesets, three dedicated electrics, and 54'-0" of fly loft gallery space above the deck. The system features a dual-loading rail system, with operating capability at the floor stage right on deck level, or at the pinrail stage right at 22'-0" above deck level. Both rails have lockdown bars. The pinrail runs the perimeter of the stage with secured catwalk access. The load rail for weight loading is 43'-0" above the deck. Linesets include 12 empty battens. All battens are 51'-0" and 1½" in diameter. See Lineset Schedule (page 8) for more detailed information. Battens can be operated as needed during performances.

MASKING SYSTEM

All soft goods are hung on battens which can be flown in or out as needed. The soft goods inventory includes: a Bermuda Blue grand drape and valence set, three sets of black velour legs and borders, two black velour traveler curtains, a seamless white bounce cyc, and a black houndstooth scrim. Main drape and travelers travel on a track, part at center, and are manually operated from stage right.

CONTROL BOOTH

Lighting, sound, and projection controls are located in an elevated booth at the rear of the house. The open window permanently allows for an unobstructed sound and sightline to the stage.



Front of House

SEATING AREA

The Summerlin Theater has a seating capacity of 284 people, with two additional accessible seating locations for customers in a wheelchair. Two seats are partial view. Aisles are sloped, with no steps anywhere in the house. There is one aisle along the front of the stage. The distance to the stage from the last row of seats is approximately 45'-0". There are two partial view seats in Row C, seats 9 and 11.



LOBBY

The performing arts center Lobby is shared with the library and is suitable for light receptions and sign-in tables. The lobby must remain accessible to the public during regular operating hours (Monday-Thursday 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Friday-Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.). There is enough space for two tables close to the theater entry doors. A box office with refrigerator is available for selling show tickets. There are 16 brass ball-top stanchions with 20 velveteen ropes of varying sizes which can be used to create a formal theatre entry line.





MEETING ROOM

The Meeting Room is located behind the main adult section of the library. The meeting room features an 85" TV with a sound bar, a blue-ray player and a glass white board. It accommodates 24 people at tables and 40 in chairs only. It is suitable for lectures and small meetings.

KITCHENETTE

The Meeting Room Kitchenette contains a refrigerator, microwave, professional coffee maker, sink, and full stove with oven. The performing arts center green room also features kitchen amenities including a large refrigerator, a microwave, and a double sink. When using the kitchenette customers must comply with Southern Nevada Health District policies and regulations. Kitchenettes and other food service areas do not have permits for uncatered food preparation and distribution.



USHERS

Ushers must be provided by all rental customers. The number of ushers will be determined by the Library District staff and agreed to in the Performing Arts Center License Agreement. In addition to helping customers find their seats, ushers are also responsible for monitoring customers to ensure that no food or drink (other than bottled water) is taken into the performing arts center. Failure to provide the agreed upon number of ushers will lead to additional fees in accordance with the Venue Fee Schedule. The Library District provides front-of-house staff for all library programming events.

CHAPERONES

Customer using a venue for an event involving minors (exclusive of audience members) are required to have at minimum two qualified adult chaperones including one adult for every 10 children for ages 0-5, one adult for every 12 children for ages 6-11, and one adult for every 15 children for ages 12-17. Chaperones must supervise and accompany minors to ensure their safety and proper behavior. Failure to provide chaperones will lead to additional fees in accordance with the Venue Fee Schedule.

ADA COMPLIANCE

Any customer who receives a request for accommodation under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act shall refer the request to Library District Staff. Please allow five business days for sign language interpreter requests to ensure availability. The Library District will make arrangements to provide services at the expense of the customer. Failure to notify staff of these requests will result in additional fees in accordance with the Venue Fee Schedule. Access to the Performing Arts Center is provided through the main lobby. Wheelchair accessibility is provided as listed on the seating diagram and ground plan. The venue was designed and operates in compliance with ADA specifications. The Library District will cover the cost for requested sign language interpreters for all library programming events.

ASSISTIVE LISTENING

The performing arts center is equipped with an assistive listening system that is available for use upon request. There are a total of 6 headsets available to audience members who may have difficulty hearing performances. Headsets are typically located in the control booth but can be relocated to serve your front-of-house needs.

Load In Area

LOADING DOCK

The loading dock can accommodate two trucks at a time and is dedicated to the performing arts center. The dock is situated immediately off of the 1,000 square foot stage shop area with a direct path stage left.

Green Room

The 440 square foot Green Room is situated off of the backstage hallway and is accessible directly from the stage and from all of the dressing rooms. It features a 12-seat dining table, couches to seat 12, an upright piano, a 42" TV with DVD player, and kitchen amenities including a large refrigerator, a microwave, and a double sink.



Dressing Rooms

This venue has two group-occupancy dressing rooms, each with a separate changing room, three 5' x 6' wardrobe racks, three 5' x 7' wardrobe racks, 12 makeup stations, 2 toilets, 2 shower stalls and 2 wash sinks. Additionally, this venue has two Star Dressing Rooms, each with a make-up station, table, shower, toilet, and 4' wardrobe rack. This venue also has one Quick Change Room with a wardrobe rack, table, sink and toilet.

This venue has a full-sized washer and dryer available for use. Please note that rental groups are required to provide their own laundry supplies.

Projections

PROJECTION SYSTEM

The projection system features both rear and front projectors perfect for movie screenings and presentations. The projector is housed on the back wall of the stage and can only be accessed by Library District staff.

Rental customers must provide their own HDMI cable and any necessary adapters to connect a user-furnished playback device to the projection system.

If a programming partner wishes to transfer PowerPoint files to the Library District computer, please load the files onto no less than 2 USB jump drives so there is a backup device.

Rental customers are welcome to connect to The Library District's free Wi-Fi to access the internet. Internet speeds are subject to customer usage and may not be sufficient for video streaming or video conferencing. We recommend downloading all video content or supplying your own internet hotspot if an internet connection is needed for your event. The Library District is not able to provide support for live-streaming events for rental customers.

Rules & Policies

VENUE USE POLICY

All Library District rental customers, programming partners, and customers must follow all local, state, and federal laws as well as all Las Vegas-Clark County Library District policies, procedures, and guidelines. A complete list of all policies can be found on the Library District Website (<https://thelibrarydistrict.org/publications/>).

PROP AND WEAPONS GUIDELINES

Any props brought into any Library District building that are meant to simulate weapons or other items prohibited by the Library Rules of Conduct must be pre-approved and follow the Programming and Event Prop Guidelines. Please speak with library staff directly at least two weeks before your program to determine which simulated props are permitted and the guidelines that must be followed before they can be brought onto the premises.

ADULT THEMES

Express written authorization is required for the presentation of events that include adult themes. Customers must request authorization for events with adult themes from the Library District before an event is marketed to the public and no less than two weeks before first use.

OPEN FLAME

Open flame devices such as candles and torches along with pyrotechnics are not permitted in Performing Arts Centers at any time. Customers may use electronic candles and other non-combusting effects to simulate flames on stage.

STROBE LIGHTS AND THEATRICAL ATMOSPHERIC EFFECTS

Express written authorization is required for the use of strobe lights and theatrical atmospheric effects.
