0 to 5 PROGRAMS

Thank you for making our programs so popular! Due to fire code, space is limited and tickets are required to enter storytime. Tickets are free and will be handed out 30 minutes prior to the event. You must be present to obtain a ticket and a ticket is good for one person only. You may need to show up at least 20 minutes before storytime begins to ensure you get a ticket. Please be on time. No one will be permitted into the program ten minutes after the program's start, even if you have a ticket.

Toddler * Tuesdays at 10:30 a.m. and 11:15 a.m. * Ages 18 to 36 months * Length: about 25 minutes

Children and parents will participate as we share songs, rhymes, and stories. Ages 18 to 36 months.

Preschool * Wednesdays at 10:30 a.m. * Ages 3 to 5 * Length: about 30 minutes

Includes stories, songs, and more to build early literacy skills and help children develop a love for books. Ages 3 to 5.

Babytime * Thursdays at 10:30 a.m. except January 1 * Ages 0 to 18 months * Length: about 25 minutes with 20 minutes of play time

Babies enjoy songs, nursery rhymes, and finger plays with their favorite adult. This program includes book-sharing time and language-enrichment activities. Ages 0 to 18 months.
