Personal Property Guidelines

Personal Property Guidelines

The Las Vegas-Clark County Library District (Library District) reserves the right to limit the type, size, and number of items brought onto library property as necessary to prevent interference with the delivery of library services and/or prevent any danger to the health and safety of any person on library property. All library use is subject to the *Library Rules of Conduct* and *Lost and Found Guidelines*.

General Guidelines

- Personal belongings must not collectively exceed 10" x 14" x 22" with the following exceptions:
 - Musical instruments
 - Assistive devices or service animals for persons with disabilities
 - Items used for medical purposes or childcare
 - Strollers used for the transport of infants, toddlers or service animals
 - One small personal item is allowed, in addition to collective measurement (i.e., purse, small handbag, lunchbox)
- Weapons or dangerous items of any kind are prohibited.
- Unsanitary personal belongings are prohibited.
- Shopping carts are prohibited.
- Cooking or any type of heating equipment is prohibited.
- Bedding is prohibited (except for use by infants or toddlers).
- Personal belongings must be kept out of walkways or aisles and must not be placed in areas that may cause risk of injury.
- Personal belongings may not be left unattended.
- The Library District is not responsible for personal items that are lost, stolen, or damaged.
- The Library District reserves the right to inspect personal belongings.

NOTE: All personal property must comply with the general guidelines, which are subject to change.
