FREE, In-Person Veteran Support Services Now Available through PILOT

PILOT, an initiative that features a wide range of essential, NO-COST services for local veterans, is now open inside the Community Resources Center at West Las Vegas Library. The FREE veterans' services that are available through PILOT include:

- Housing assistance (rent, deposits, utilities)
- Food resources
- Transportation support
- One-on-one help navigating services

The PILOT office is open every Tuesday and Thursday from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. (Walk-ins are welcome from 10 a.m. – 11 a.m. on these same days.) To learn what documentation to bring with you and make your appointment, visit the [PILOT webpage](#).

Special Exhibit Explores Art of the Holocaust

Now on view through May 17 at The Studio inside Sahara West Library, "Catharsis: Art of the Holocaust" is a powerful exhibition presented by the Nevada Holocaust Museum. The exhibit features works spanning dance, poetry, sculpture, textiles, painting, and culinary arts all created by Holocaust survivors, many with ties to Nevada. Each piece tells a story of lives interrupted and families lost, while reminding us of the human spirit's ability to rebuild, remember, and affirm life.
